2020 VAIL GOLF CLUB SEASON PASS/RESIDENT ID FOR INDIVIDUALS

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO WANT TO QUALIFY FOR IN-DISTRICT DISCOUNTED RATES AND ISSUANCE OF A RESIDENT RATE OR GOLF PASS ARE:

1. An individual who owns (or whose spouse owns) not less than 50% interest in taxable real estate within the District boundaries and therefore is assessed a mill-levy tax by the VRD.

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2. In the case of an individual who leases, a Colorado driver's license at the lease address must accompany application. Lease must run through end of the season or termination date will be placed on the face of pass. Right to pass terminates if lease terminates or applicant moves out of district. Lease must be for at least six months. Lease must contain landlord or property management company phone number for verification purposes.

RESTRICTIONS ON MULTIPLE OWNERS OF PERSONAL OR REAL PROPERTY:

Multiple, partnership, or corporate owners of real or personal property may have up to four individuals eligible for the pass/ID card program as long as their name appears on the property tax bill.

PROPERTIES NOT INCLUDED IN THE VAIL RECREATION DISTRICT BOUNDARIES:

The Vail Golf Club pass/ID program is only available to owners of real and/or personal property within the Vail Recreation District (VRD) who are assessed a mill-levy tax by the Vail Parks and Recreation District. Residency within the boundary limits of the Town of Vail does not guarantee taxes are paid to the VRD. Although the District boundary is most of the area generally considered to be the Town of Vail, certain parcels are not within the District. Additionally, portions of certain subdivisions that are not part of the Town of Vail are part of the District.

INTERVAL OWNERSHIPS:

A timeshare owner who can establish his/her ownership during the time period of their stay in Vail may be eligible for a golf pass or ID card good only during the period of their ownership. Interval owners must provide (1) a copy of the deed and (2) a letter from the management association confirming the exact dates of the ownership period.

WHO ARE "IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBERS":

Season passholders may obtain golf passes/ID cards for their immediate family members. Immediate family members include a spouse and any dependent children under the age of eighteen (18).

Anyone using false identification or information in obtaining an ID card and/or recreational pass will forfeit the card or pass without refund. Police will be notified to prosecute for "theft of services," trespassing and violation of the District's rules and procedures.

TEE TIMES MUST BE CANCELED AT LEAST TWO (2) HOURS IN ADVANCE BY CALLING THE VAIL GOLF CLUB PRO SHOP. THE CHARGE FOR A NO SHOW OR NO CANCELLATION CALL WILL BE \$25. PASSHOLDER/ID HOLDER WHO MADE THE TEE TIME WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FINE, AND SUCH PARTY'S CREDIT CARD MAY BE CHARGED.

Punch passes will be treated the same as cash. There will be no compensation for lost cards.

Vail Resident Gold Pass: \$1,400 Eagle County Gold Pass: \$1,900

Tee times may be reserved seven days in advance during the peak season. This pass includes green fee, cart rental, range pass, locker and club storage (per health order). Vail residents must prove residency at time of purchase. The pass will not be honored until all residency qualifications are met. Proof is the responsibility of the purchaser.

Vail Resident Silver Pass: \$800 Young Adult: \$450* (18-29 years) *w/ cart: \$1,000

During peak season (June 26–Sept. 7), tee times may be reserved two days in advance Monday–Thursday and one day in advance Friday–Sunday. Pass restricted June 26–Sept. 7 on holidays and Friday–Sunday. During early and fall seasons, tee times may be made anytime. Vail residents must prove residency at time of purchase. The pass will not be honored until all residency qualifications are met. Proof is the responsibility of the purchaser.

Eagle County Resident Silver Pass: \$1,100 Young Adult \$450* (18-29 years) *w/ cart: \$1,000

During peak season (June 26–Sept. 7), tee times may be reserved two days in advance Monday–Thursday and one day in advance Friday–Sunday. Pass restricted June 26–Sept. 7 on holidays and Friday–Sunday. During early and fall seasons, tee times may be made anytime. Eagle County residents must prove residency at time of purchase. The pass will not be honored until all residency qualifications are met. Proof is the responsibility of the purchaser.

Junior Gold Pass: \$300

During peak season (June 26–Sept. 7), tee times may be reserved two days in advance Monday–Thursday and one day in advance Friday–Sunday. Pass restricted June 26–Sept. 7 on holidays and Friday–Sunday. Juniors must pass Rules & Etiquette Test. The pass will not be honored until qualifications are met.

Junior Silver Pass: \$150

Junior silver passholders can play on a space-available basis during the shoulder season and after 3 p.m. during peak season (June 26–Sept. 7).

Parent/Junior Pass: \$250 Option with cart: \$450

Parent/Junior passholders can play on a space-available basis during the shoulder season and after 3 p.m. during peak season (June 26–Sept. 7). One adult and one junior. Designate one adult per pass.

“FLEX” Vail Resident 10-Round Punch Pass: \$650 Vail Resident “FLEX” 20, 9-Round Punch Pass: \$700*

Tee times may be made anytime, seven days in advance. Vail residents must prove residency at time of purchase. The pass will not be honored until all residency qualifications are met. Proof is the responsibility of the purchaser. *The 20, 9-hole punch pass are 9 holes per punch and may be punched twice for an 18-hole round.

“FLEX” Eagle County 10-Round Punch Pass: \$700 Eagle County “FLEX” 20, 9-Round Punch Pass: \$750*

Tee times may be made anytime, seven days in advance. Eagle County residents must prove residency at time of purchase. The pass will not be honored until all residency qualifications are met. Proof is the responsibility of the purchaser. *The 20, 9-hole punch pass are 9 holes per punch and may be punched twice for an 18-hole round.

“FLEX” Vail Resident 10-Round Punch Pass w/ Cart: \$850 Eagle County “FLEX” w/ Cart: \$925

Tee times may be made anytime, seven days in advance. Vail residents must prove residency at time of purchase. The pass will not be honored until all residency qualifications are met. Proof is the responsibility of the purchaser.

Vail Resident 20, 9-Hole Punch Pass AFTER 1 P.M. ONLY: \$550

During peak season (June 26–Sept. 7), tee times may be reserved AFTER 1 P.M. two days in advance Monday–Thursday and one day in advance Friday–Sunday. Pass restricted June 28–Sept. 2 on holidays and Friday–Sunday. During early and fall seasons, tee times may be made anytime.



2020 VAIL GOLF CLUB PASSHOLDER/RESIDENT RULES

Initial Box

1. Conduct: Any misconduct deemed serious by Vail Golf Club staff may result in pass being revoked or suspended. Any verbal threat directed toward, or physical contact with, a member of the Vail Golf Club staff shall be deemed to be serious misconduct.

2. Liquor License: The Vail Recreation District owns the liquor license for the entire Vail Golf Club and course. Colorado State Law prohibits your alcohol on their licensed premise. No off-site coolers are allowed.

3. Pace of Play Guidelines: In the interest of a positive experience for all users of the course and minimizing fees, Vail Golf Club strictly enforces a 4:07 18-hole round. All golfers are expected to complete the first nine holes of play in or under two hours and two minutes and to continue on this pace through the 18th green. Our staff is here to assist you in any way possible and to help you play in a timely fashion. Please respect our policy and our staff as they implement the course policy. Vail Golf Club staff has been charged with maintaining the appropriate pace of play, and to that end, the staff is authorized and required to direct you to play faster, skip holes if out of position or leave the course if unwilling to work with our staff to complete play in a timely manner.

4. Dress Code Enforced: Collared shirt and proper golf attire required for all golfers and any visitors to the course. No denim, tank tops or cut-off shorts are allowed on the course or practice facility.

5. Check-in: Players must check in for play at the pro shop 15 minutes prior to play. Your starter slip will be generated in the pro shop. You must present your receipt to the starter prior to play.

6. Reservation Rules: Pass and punchcard holders are required to follow all tee time reservation rules presented above on the pass application.

7. Golf Carts: All golf cart users must have a valid driver's license. Users are responsible for any cart damage while operating the cart.
